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# Dear Reader

To reach the end of another year being able to be proud of the achieved results is living proof that the legacy left by Patron Antonio Meneghetti continues to impact and transform the reality of more than 5,000 people through the Cultural and Educational Projects of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation. In 2022, once again, there is no shortage of reasons to celebrate and share!

Returning from the pandemic period, the projects were restructured, adapted and, above all, strengthened in order to get even further. The team of professionals working at the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation increased, established partnerships and delivered valuable results for people and society through 30 Projects, organized into three programs: the Cultural and Educational Program, the International Center for Humanist Art and Culture Recanto Maestro and Research and Dissemination of Ontopsychology.


In schools, the new Recreate project brought attention, care and creativity to schools, helping students who presented greater learning difficulties due to school closures. The multidisciplinary team went to the municipalities, helping in the task of educating. Likewise, the project We Are Together expanded its operations to 16 cities. Through training sessions, it worked alongside with public school teachers and launched the School of Pedagogical Innovations. This extension course, in its first edition, trained more than 100 professionals. The project Awakening Intelligent Education through Reading celebrated the acquisition of its second Itinerant Library, allowing it (with its two vehicles) to reach an audience of more than 3,800 children, who received visits in their schools.

In partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade, the Youth Identity Scholarship benefited 791 undergraduate students throughout the year. Through the Volare project, another international training opportunity was offered to students: 67 AMF students attended the course "Diplomacy 4.0, Human Rights and Cosmopolitan Communication in an Environment of Multicultural Debate", which had a module held at the Peace Palace in the Netherlands. Back in Brazil, the AMF Futsal team also achieved unprecedented feats. After winning the title of champion in the State University Games, the team traveled to Brasilia to represent the state in the Brazilian University Games, in September.

The Fanciullo Collection project also innovated. In 2022, it launched two new titles. The work "A New Generation" is written by young people for young people: undergraduate students shared their formative and growth experiences. The second issue of the year was a Christmas present for 2,500 children at the FAM Meeting of Projects. "Os Desafios da Fazendinha do Bosque" (The challenges of the forest animal farm) is a book to play and learn - composed of 25 cognitive challenges with the proposal of incentivating the intelligence and creativity of readers.

Society in Action project - second edition: the public notice for cultural and educational projects involved schools and organizations from 10 cities. Through the 54 contemplated projects, it was possible to develop actions that promoted the revitalization of public spaces, incentivize reading and cognitive development of children, promote financial and patrimonial education and instigate the continuous training of teachers.

While all these projects were taking place in the region, at the Recanto Maestro International Center for Humanist Art and Culture activities did not stop either. The project Oikos Selective Waste Collection has established itself as an example of sustainability, expanding its operations to all spaces in Recanto Maestro, providing for the correct disposal of 62,450 tons of recyclable material. Around 75 young people, increasingly aware of their role in an ecobiological environment, had their first job opportunity in the Cultivating the Know-how project: through the cultivation of flowers or vegetables they developed human and social skills. The cultivation spaces have earned - by merit - the status of an object of appreciation and receive visits, on a daily basis, from schools and community visitors. Feeling Recanto Maestro allowed 3,724 students to get to know the training spaces of the International Center for Humanist Art and Culture Recanto Maestro, in addition to independent visits. Coming from the most varied regions, these young people were able to learn about the guiding pillars of the place and the opportunities for work and development.



The Ontopsychological Science - the guideline for the actions of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation - gained prominence at national and international levels. In June, in partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade, the International Meeting "Person & Society" was held in The Hague, the Netherlands. The Symposium had 180 participants from four countries (Brazil, the Netherlands, Ukraine and Italy). Among the guests was Her Royal Highness, Princess Laurentien Brinkhorst of the Netherlands - a great personality and intelligence in the country's contemporary history, with an outstanding career in Journalism, Education and in the Social area.

At this grandiose event, the bilingual edition of the book "Antonio Meneghetti on... Person and society" was launched. On the occasion, the themes dealt with in the book were used to conduct the panels. Another book that was published in the Portuguese-Italian format was the book "Antonio Meneghetti on... To the new leaders of the future".

Still in 2022, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation, in partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade, continued the now traditional course for leaders called Alta Formação Empresarial (High-level Business Training), now organized with classes for beginners in the study and application of Ontopsychology, and for veterans who have been it for a longer time. Among the various meetings, there was an international module, which was held in the Netherlands and Italy with, in addition to classes, technical visits to large companies. Following the essence bequeathed by Acad. Prof. Antonio Meneghetti, it was resumed the realization of the Isomaster School, a project aimed at great businessmen in an immersion of confrontation with the highest knowledge of Ontopsychology.

To close the year, the 5th Meeting of Projects gathered, at Recanto Maestro, 2,500 children, who participated in the cultural and educational projects of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation. The Magic and Joy of Living were celebrated with a circus show, Christmas decorations (and Santa Claus), many gifts, and ended coloring the sky with 2,000 balloons that scattered 20,000 seeds of native trees throughout the region.

A lot of the work carried out by the Foundation is expressed throughout this Activity Report; although the whole of it does not fit in these pages. However, sharing part of this work with the community that collaborates, believes and shares Antonio Meneghetti's ideals is a duty, a pleasure and an honor. At the end of 2022, the great commitment that remains is to follow the mission of continuing to train the human person as a social function, always in search of a society that is humanly aware, ecologically sustainable and responsible for life.

# The objective of the Foundation

According to its Patron Antonio Meneghetti:

## PROMOTING HUMANISM AND PUBLIC WELL-BEING

"In the objective sense, the Foundation is a legal entity to establish that a private asset is placed in accordance with the resolutions of the State. And this asset, from this moment on, is approved by the authority, administered and managed according to objectives indicated and specified by those who make their own assets available through the Foundation.

And these objectives are recognized, the State identifies and authorizes them. It is not always a consensus, but the State makes itself guarantor, makes itself responsible. Naturally, the State, before agreeing to this availability, with this guarantee, analyzes whether the wishes, the proposals of those who give this asset, are foreseen in its specific legal ordering.

### ***Why create a foundation?***

- I decided to create the Foundation for two reasons: Recognizing that I have generated wealth, I cannot say immense, but certainly remarkable, and having generated this wealth in several countries, with different laws, the first thing I was concerned about was that in my death, which can occur at any time, it is not fair that all of this will be managed only by someone who has had a family connection with me.

I consider myself a valuable mind and, in this sense, an excellent servant of life. Therefore, an operator who is in coordination with the fundamental values of life, from a human point of view. And, therefore, I wanted these goods, this wealth, to be protected, made available to serve as reinforcement and addition to others who will accept this idea, this way of enlivening humanism. But also because of a specificity, the style of everything that was the Ontopsychological School. This is the first aspect.

The second is that what I have done, I accomplished within a participation, an international, universal conscience. I am someone who found himself within an immensity and understood things, and that these things belong to everyone. Therefore, I also legally took care that all this remains in the memory, in the renewal of the generations that are part of this thought of perennial humanism. First of all, the successive operators, or Foundation administrators, will always have the choice to collaborate with what the project is – I would not say the ideal, but the substantial project, the DNA of well-being, in an economic sense, in a rational sense, in a political sense.

An individual, in order to be himself, has a need that the other is well too, because one cannot wear a beautiful outfit amid people in rags. A beautiful outfit is beautiful when there are others well dressed. Therefore, this raises and motivates the project of each man to become, to always be carried out at progressively higher horizons.

In relation to reciprocity, I have the idea that the good vital example must provoke another intelligent being, because we come from the same unity, the maternal unity of the great life. And the growth of one individual also motivates the other. And that means that with every pleasure, every satisfaction, there is an equal reaction of responsibility. That is, to the pleasure I have, to know how to respond with an innovation that authenticates, that expands this pleasure. I would say that it is in the biological DNA of any man who loves himself, to be himself and, therefore, inevitably to be with others.

### ***Why create a Foundation in Brazil?***

- Yes... Brazil... I believe that Brazil chose me, because for me Brazil was a land of Indians, distant. A happy land that had no need for anything. However, when I visited it, when I met this Brazil, this mixture of so many peoples, this Brazil that, of all countries in the world, is perhaps the one that has the highest example of democracy, of respect for one another.

I have not found this high level of kindness in any other country. And that may already be globalization, a vast territory in fact, of ethnic principles, historical principles and so many other things. And then, it is a country that has guaranteed tomorrow, the future. That is, I chose a country that I know will have a major role, so it was not convenient for me to open, for example, a foundation in France, or in England, or the United States, because I feel them to be old countries, already consummated. Perhaps, temporarily, they have already made their own history.

Because the spirit, through history, changes its peoples, elevates one, lowers the other and, in my view, Brazil is, above all, in tomorrow, in its future. And it has a young population, young from so many points of view. Despite so many colonial defects of some kind, Brazil has an innocence, it does not have decrepit stereotypes like old Europe. Or else, as messianically legalized as in the United States, where each one is a priest of education, of democracy for all others. These are the reasons: youth and space in the future. These are the two aspects, above all, that convinced me. And to deposit knowledge that, without a doubt, will be the future of scientific evolution. That is, depositing this seed in winning countries, that was my functional utilitarian logic.

I do not see Antonio Meneghetti, I see the Brazilian humanist intelligence that will instrumentalize what I started and that will make innovations. There is a Brazilian expression that I like: innovating and improving! The Foundation will do this, a novelty of science for public well-being, but with a Brazilian rationality management\*.







# Antonio Meneghetti

## A scientist dedicated to the human

Academician Professor Antonio Meneghetti (1936, Italy - 2013, Brazil) was a scientist of rare education, obtained four doctorates according to the classical evaluation criteria, being a PhD of Philosophy and of Social Sciences, from the Pontifical University of Saint Thomas Aquinas (Rome); a PhD in Theology, by the Pontifical Lateran University (Rome) and obtained the title of Grand Doktor Nauk in Psychology, by the Supreme Commission of Interacademic Evaluation of the Russian Federation. In the last 50 years, he formalized the Ontopsychological Science, which studies man, how he is constituted, how he works and what he needs to develop and carry out his project in a winning way. He wrote more than 50 books, most of which were translated into English, Portuguese, Spanish, Russian and Chinese. He gave lectures and conferences around the world, taking forward the discoveries and knowledge of the Ontophychology.

Prof. Meneghetti had in the education of young people one of his main activities, because, for him, it was essential to educate man as a person in the social function and he understood this as a fundamental point for the development of society. He started working with young people in Italy when he was the director of an orphanage and coordinated the Scuola College project. Regarding the training of people, especially young people, he created several Ecobiological Centers in different countries in the world (Russia, Latvia, Ukraine, Italy). In Brazil, he founded the International Center for Humanist Art and Culture Recanto Maestro, where he founded the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade, a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Education in 2007; the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation in 2010, which aims to safeguard and perpetuate the results of the Ontopsychological Science; in addition to other institutions that are also responsible for continuing his work.

To help to educate, in a serious and coherent way, therefore, children, youth and adults, is the way in which the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation commits itself to the - accomplished - will of its Patron.

# The Antonio Meneghetti Foundation

## As an orchestrator of human education

The Antonio Meneghetti Foundation for Scientific, Humanistic, Cultural and Educational Research (FAM) was created on January 29th, 2010, by Acad. Prof. Antonio Meneghetti, who in life had the intention of preserving the physical and intellectual heritage of his work in Brazil. The priority for the Foundation's existence was defined by him as education and the incentive to culture and research. FAM's headquarters are located in the Recanto Maestro District, in the city of São João do Polésine - RS. It is a place based on humanist education and development that presents to Brazil and to the world - from the integral human being - how science, education and entrepreneurship can generate economic, environmental and, above all, human growth.

The institution encourages and promotes education, culture and scientific research by means of three Programs: Cultural and Educational, Diffusion of Ontopsychology and the International Center for Humanist Art and Culture Recanto Maestro. These projects are based on the Ontopsychological Science with works that focus on Humanist Culture, which sees man as a being capable of carrying out the responsible and integral development of his own life. For this reason, all projects, despite working on different areas, complement each other and go together to train their participants, consequently determining a better humane society. Since 2015, the projects have intensified their support to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), defined by the United Nations (UN). With these goals and targets, it is intended the world balanced evolution in three dimensions: economic, social and environmental.

With a lot of work and dedication, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation has grown exponentially each year in the promotion of educational, cultural and science promotion activities. Its results are evident when children and young people begin to participate in the projects on a voluntary basis, and have a rapid development, generating a highlight in their personal and professional manner. Likewise, when new research on the Ontopsychological Science is carried out and published nationally and internationally.

# The Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade

As the core of scientific  
and human knowledge production

The Antonio Meneghetti Foundation encourages and supports the activities of the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade, which was accredited by the Brazilian Ministry of Education in 2007 and began its activities in 2008, at the Recanto Maestro International Center for Humanist Art and Culture. In this period of 15 years, it has so far built and created 6 Undergraduate Courses (Bachelors in Business Administration, Accounting Sciences, Law, Ontopsychology, Information Systems and the Degree in Pedagogy) and 2 Lato Sensu Graduate Courses (the MBA Business Identity and the Specialization in Ontopsychology). In addition to numerous Extension Projects that encompass and integrate the community of the Quarta Colônia Region, and scientific research activities, in 2022, it inaugurated its fourth educational building, which will soon receive courses in Gastronomic Sciences and the Technologist in Hospitality.

The AMF proposes to develop its academic activities - undergraduate, graduate, research, extension and innovation - based on the diffusion of a differential that involves the development of personality, understood as intelligence centered on the specific action of knowing how to do, in which the person's role is fundamental and determinant. The Ontopsychological Science guides AMF's pedagogical guidelines and it is also its greatest differential in the training of young future professionals in different fields, with five major education pillars: study, work, high morality, science and internationality, culminating in the formation of leadership.

Since the beginning of its activities, the AMF has put at the forefront of all its objectives the role of the human being able to contribute, to collaborate, to undertake and improve the society to which he belongs. The ontopsychological methodology awakens and encourages its students towards entrepreneurship (entrepreneurial attitude and leadership), towards work as an opportunity for personal growth and improvement, personal and social development.

The AMF consolidates a new scenario in Brazilian higher education, which unites human development with progressive economic and social growth. It is an educational institution based on the logic of Humanist Culture, of interdisciplinarity according to the ontopsychological approach, aiming to prepare men able to solve the constant demands of a society in continuous evolution. This way, at AMF, knowledge, culture and technique are at the service of training authentic and accomplished people.

This proposal is possible for our college because its theoretical teaching is combined with successful practice. Our teachers and professors, in addition to having differentiated academic education, are professionals who have practical experience in the areas they teach, and carry out their personal and professional training on a continuous basis, more than by necessity, by a lifestyle.

# Antonio Meneghetti Foundation

## Putting the precepts of the United Nations into practice

In July 2018, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation became part of the group of organizations representing civil society with the United Nations. The application of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation to occupy this consultative status was analyzed and accepted by the Committee on NGOs (NGO Branch) of the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (ECOSOC), the arm of the organization responsible for granting consultative status to non-governmental organizations.

What does it mean? According to UN ECOSOC Resolution 1996/31, organizations in special consultative status are able to offer specialized information on those topics in which the entity is competent. In the case of FAM, its candidacy was based on the application of Ontopsychological Pedagogy in practical projects focused on education, fostering culture, citizenship and socio-economic development in the region where it is based, always bearing in mind the Sustainable Development Goals.

Upon receiving special consultative status, the FAM is able to, among others, designate representatives for the United Nations headquarters located in New York (USA), Vienna (Austria) and Geneva (Switzerland); participate in United Nations events, conferences and activities for civil society organizations; submit written statements that are relevant to the work of the Economic and Social Council with respect to the field in which the organization is competent; be called to give oral testimony before the ECOSOC; receive consultations from the ECOSOC and its subsidiary bodies; receive requests to carry out research and studies or prepare articles for the reading of the commission.

Broadly speaking, from the granting of the special consultative status, the FAM is an active voice for civil society within the scope of the UN Economic and Social Council. In this way, it can assist in the public discussions of this body, taking forward proposals for successful practices carried out in Brazil to contribute to the construction of a new global citizenship.

The Antonio Meneghetti Foundation continuously supports projects that value the human being, society, science, economics, art, culture, and intensifies its activities following the precepts defined by the UN. The following points stand out in the projects: the promotion of learning opportunities; the encouragement of a healthy life and well-being; the protection, recovery and promotion of the sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems; among other practices implemented by the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Given the term sustainability, its real meaning is understood as growth that meets the ecological-economic-social-cultural requirements of the person, of the communities and the social context. However, it is essential, first of all, to start sustainability through each person, because the social context is a construction of the realization of people as human beings. This is the importance of human capital formation, of increasing accountability for personal actions and their arising results.

By contributing to the realization and achievement of the SDGs, the FAM projects teach children, adolescents and young people the value of responsibility, respect, autonomy, collaborative work, care for the environment and the joy of improving our own society to better live together in it!

## Cultural and Educational




# BALL FORWARD

It is a project of integral education, uniting mind and body, with the purpose of developing children and young people in a complete way. It carries out sports activities, mainly soccer, integrating boys and girls. The logic of the game is, every day, to be the best of yourself in sport so that you can be your best in life. It holds weekly classes, dividing students into four categories, from 04 to 15 year-olds.

With technical and pedagogical support, students carry out activities in groups after school hours. Through the Project, children learn, mainly, that winning is, rather than just the objective, the result of actions and continuous and disciplined work, a point that serves to any sphere of society. The project takes place in the municipalities of Restinga Sêca, São João do Polêsine and Nova Palma.



# Awakening Intelligent Education through Reading



The Project Awakening Intelligent Education through Reading aims to stimulate the reading of texts and the reading of the world, altogether. Through books from children's and youth literature, it seeks to awaken the intelligence and creativity of beginners. With the proposal to reach more distant spaces and more children and young people, it operates through two Itinerant Libraries.

The Project operates in public schools and neighborhoods, taking carefully selected books, based on the message and the artistic and cultural value of the work, to children and young people. The books are worked on by professionals, from pre-reading to post-reading, giving space for readers to insert themselves in the stories, based on their realities.

The reading of different books shows how information reacts in each one, enabling a self-learning process, considering the text as a whole. In addition, reading as a tool serves to stimulate the cognitive process, to increase vocabulary and expand worldview.

## The Student Housing Buildings

The Students' House Project provides student housing designed in a comfortable, pleasant and safe way for countless young people from distant cities, who choose Recanto Maestro as the place to take their education. The structure consists of two buildings, with double suites and kitchen, laundry and collective living area. It is configured as a pedagogical house, since it also demands responsibility from the residents, as they are the only ones in charge of keeping the environment always clean and organized.

The Project selects the young people who need the most and deserve good student housing, as well as monitors everything from their moving in until the moment students leave the house. Through a coordination in each of the two houses – female and male – there is always assistance and control of the residents. By profile, students are divided into pairs, having to organize themselves with the division of space.

Living together in the House allows for greater autonomy and encourages a coherent and organized lifestyle, while enabling social and collective coexistence, adaptation to the environment and to the group. The supervision of the coordination ensures that everyone complies with the house rules, providing a proper environment for everyone. In addition, in practical terms, the Houses offer the possibility of access to the college for 98 students concurrently.

## New facilities to accommodate students

In February, two more buildings with 18 apartments each were made available, one for boys and one for girls. The buildings are located in Residencial Recanto Maestro and serve as an extension of the Students' House. This measure was necessary, as the 27 rooms in the two houses were no longer enough to accommodate all the students. The new spaces follow the same rules as of the Students' House.



## Reception for new students

In March, the students' house was prepared for the reception of new students. During this period of arrival, in addition to checking the structures, veteran residents are also prepared for this welcome. At the beginning of the year alone, more than 200 new residents came to live in the Students' House, coming from different municipalities.



# Volare

# Main actions Developed in 2022



## Partnership with Unitar

Through the partnership with the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR), advanced principles for internationality are studied. The contents presented in these customized training programs use professors and materials usually aimed at training diplomats, government officials, representatives of non-governmental organizations, international authorities and other opinion makers. Thus, the following topics are studied: strengthening of multilateralism, promotion of social and economic sustainability, promotion of peace and resilience and humanitarian action, strengthening the implementation of the 2030 agenda.



## Opportunity for training and human development

Volare allowed more than 40 students to have the opportunity of a training experience at the Peace Palace, in The Hague (Holland). The Palace is an administrative building under international law, which houses the International Court of Justice (the main judicial organ of the United Nations), the Permanent Court of Arbitration (PCA), the Hague Academy of International Law and the Peace Palace Library. The students' worldview became wider as they got to know each Dutch company, museum and tourist attraction.

# FANCIULLO

## Collection

Through playful and educational publications aimed at children and young people, the Fanciullo Collection proposes to bring functional and valuable messages, in addition to encouraging the habit of reading. The book is launched by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation, with its own resources, registered with ISBN, and addresses relevant and contemporary themes.

At least one new book edition is printed annually to be distributed free of charge to children participating in the Foundation's projects. With each new edition, an Antonio Meneghetti Foundation Project is chosen to propose and organize the book. It is then its coordinator's responsibility to take, in a different way, the Project's message to a wider audience.

As a concrete result, seven books in the collection have already been published: *Os desafios da Fazendinha do Bosque* (2022); *Uma Nova geração* (2022); *As cores do meu mundo: uma aventura para colorir* (2021); *Identidade Jovem: incentivando o protagonismo responsável* (2020); *Meu guia de práticas saudáveis* (2020); *Despertando autores: descobrindo novos mundos* (2019); *Um passeio com Gregório: aventuras na mata* (2018).

All of them are freely available to FAM Projects' students. As an indirect result, thousands of children and teenagers received books to read, play, learn and, mainly, to develop themselves based on practical and true teachings.




## Launching of the book "Os Desafios da Fazendinha do Bosque"

# SCHOOL OF LIFE

Designed for students who are starting an undergraduate course, the School of Life Project encourages work and action, using various workshops taught by professionals who aim to develop essential aspects for contemporary youth and adults. The project is an initiation for young people who still don't have experience and want to enter the job market.

Classes take place weekly, lasting two hours, with workshops on: professional and personal development, financial education, body in motion and Portuguese language. The workshops are taught by professionals in the afternoon in order to be complementary to the undergraduate class schedule.

The Project helps much more than just technical development, but also to build an initial maturity and change of posture in relation to the need to seek autonomy. Young people who participate in the classes end up acquiring a first experience that gives them more maturity and security to enter the job market.

# School of Pedagogical INNOVATIONS



The School of Pedagogical Innovations project is an extension course promoted by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation in partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade. Its target audience is educators from elementary to university level, in addition to other professionals who work or are interested in the educational field. The course aims to develop reflection on the current moment of education and the construction of a new pedagogy for society and future generations, approaching the theme: "Education and humanism: continuing education and improvement".

The initiative for the course came after the identification of a need with implementation of the We Are Together Project, started in 2020, developing continuing education, benefiting 1,500 educators from municipal and state schools, covering the municipalities of the Fourth Colony of Italian Immigration and the central region.

Classes take place at the AMF campus, in the Recanto Maestro International Center for Humanist Art and Culture. The course is organized in six meetings, fortnightly, on Saturdays, allowing the broad participation of all teachers.

The addressed topics were: Humanism and Education, Lifestyle and Creativity, (Inter)active Methodologies and Technological Tools, Human Formation, Transforming Education, Postmodernism, Educational Entrepreneurship, among others. Totaling 52 hours of courses with AMF professors and guests.

The We Are Together project started as a result of the pandemic and remains in constant expansion. It is a project that aims to carry out various pedagogical support activities, which is offered to schools and teachers from municipalities in the region that need to adapt to the constant changes that occur in the educational environment. To this end, it provides humanized continuing education to groups of teachers, covering aspects that guide the daily life of contemporary schools, conducting workshops based on the Ontopsychological Pedagogy, the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the Brazilian National Common Core Curriculum (BNCC).

During the Program's activities, which are organized for each school, training is carried out with the aim of promoting a dynamic in which teachers can express their ideas and anxieties; besides studying and discussing texts that enable the practical application of this content in the daily practice of teaching.

The scope is to develop their self-appreciation as a person and a professional, based on each one's own identity, and on the reflection on the work in a coexistence of dialogue, construction of new ideas, development of creativity and new ways of being, knowing and doing. 

Youth and Technology is a project aimed at teenagers and young people that takes place in partnership with public institutions and Information Technology and educational companies, such as Grupo Meta and Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade. It aims to combine technology with an incentive to seek personal development and autonomy. Youth and Technology brings a new view on the digital world as a work and learning tool for young people who, many times, use this resource only in a non-productive way. To this end, it carries out technology and human development activities in its practices, also focusing on the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

This way, the project proposes interactions between Information Technology professionals, undergraduate and high school students, providing an exchange of experiences through practical and dynamic group activities. In addition to the possibility of integral training, the project also helps in the acquisition of technical skills that can open doors in the job market and encourage the construction of a professional career. As a consequence, the project generates results in the region where it is inserted, showing the possibilities and opportunities in the area.

In recent years, Youth and Technology has focused on supporting teachers in the use of technological tools in order to meet the demands generated by online classes. Thus, it adapted to help demonstrate technology as a pedagogical tool for this new way of conducting education. After this period, starting in 2023 it will focus again on actions aimed at young people, having as its main direction the human education based on technology.

The etymology of the word Oikos, which refers to "home", explains the mission of Oikos Education. Taking care of your environment, your society, your body. The project establishes partnerships with schools to work on the notion of integrating man and nature, referring each child and young person to their natural project as part of the universe.

It conducts environmental education classes in a sense of valuing the body and its interaction with the environment, it also makes vegetable gardens and carries out the revitalization of gardens and selective waste collection. The activities, ranging from environmental awareness to practices, are planned and implemented with the guidance of professors and monitors and supervised by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation.

The production of vegetables and flower gardens teaches, in addition to technique, the contact with the soil, which is essential for human development. In addition, the environments must be cultivated by the students themselves, with or without the presence of teachers, making them responsible for their production and, also, the benefits of their fruits. In 2022, the project was carried out in partnership with the schools and projects contemplated by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation's public notice, entitled "Society in Action".

## YOUTH ORCHESTRA **RECANTO MAESTRO**

The Recanto Maestro Youth Orchestra is composed of strings, wind and percussion instruments under the responsibility of children and young people from the region, who find in music an opportunity to exalt beauty and aesthetics. Music classes include, in addition to the technique, making young people responsible for their individual work within the Orchestra's large group. The Orchestra is managed by Associação OntoArte and receives financial incentives from sponsors and supporting companies.

It teaches different instruments in small groups in the towns of Agudo, Faxinal do Soturno, Restinga Sêca, Santa Maria, São João do Polêsine and Silveira Martins. On Saturdays, those students who are part of the children's orchestra and those from the youth orchestra group gather at Recanto Maestro for orchestral rehearsals, from 9am to 6pm.

In addition to the cultural result (being the only orchestra in the region), there is the personal result in each of the participants, who take up a commitment to the group, and must be responsible for their participation and constant improvement to keep up with their colleagues.

# ReCriate

The Recreate Project aims to aid students from the municipal education network who have some difficulty in their school learning. Thus, Recriate seeks to assist these students to develop them in an integral way, in social, cognitive, emotional and physical well-being aspects. With that, in the execution of the Project, a multidisciplinary team is involved, with a pedagogue, a psychologist, a speech therapist and undergraduate students from the Pedagogy course.

The team articulates between health and education in order to bring gain results to the participants involved, acting as a reinforcement in the schools and municipalities where they visit. Classes are worked through ludic activities and pedagogical games, developing reasoning skills, learning, motricity, concentration, phonological awareness, organization, memory, among other aspects.

Recriate works on the premise that learning difficulties are one of the main barriers to success in adult life. Thus, an intervention at the appropriate age enables the complete development and discovery of the student's potential.

## Development of pedagogical skills

These skills end up culminating in the enjoyment of school life, which is also guided by the work of professionals in the pedagogy area. Pedagogical skills develop the individual by stimulating cognitive activity and reasoning, helping with literacy, reading and writing. To develop these skills, educational games, outdoor activities, solving mathematical operations, crossword puzzles, word searches, drawings and other activities that stimulate creativity are developed.

## Development of listening skills

Through the work of a speech therapist, the participating children developed concentration, auditory memory and phonological awareness. Auditory skills are essential for the complete development of students and their relationship with society. This type of incentive happens with the development of games, oral activities, broken telephone game, text interpretation and storytelling.

## Development of social-emotional skills

Socio-emotional skills help with communication, expression of feelings, empathy, teamwork and self-confidence. Hence the importance of a professional psychologist, mediating the internal relationship of children with their insertion in the social group. To develop these skills, some activities are carried out, such as vegetable garden cultivation, sales practice day, activities with special guests and other practices that stimulate interaction and team work.

# Weaving Pieces of Knowledge



The Weaving Pieces of Knowledge Project has the proposal of registering cultural heritage through heritage education and/or education for heritage, whether it is tangible or intangible, which constitutes the territory of participating students. From the identification of their cultural, social and biological roots, children and young people feel prepared and confident, increasing their self-esteem and personal acceptance.

To this end, it works in the format of visits to formal and informal education spaces with the presentation of relevant themes, followed by a pedagogical challenge, which involves children and young people in seeking social and individual traits related to their way of life and daily life.

To seal the commitment with the registration of historical and cultural heritage, the project also holds the Cultural Contest Tecendo Saberes (Weaving Pieces of Knowledge), from which students are challenged to become even more involved, and autonomously, in carrying out a challenge. The best works are awarded.

# Y Scholarship Identity Young

This project happens in partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade and is a financial incentive for students coming from families of small farmers, traders and service providers, so that they can start their studies and seek their autonomy, with quality a proper structure.

The Scholarship is a decisive factor for entering Higher Education, as it was created with the aim of helping in this very decisive and transforming moment in the lives of families and young people. It provides assistance in the form of a discount of up to 40% on the monthly fee for students of Business Administration, Accounting, Law, Ontopsychology, Pedagogy and Information Systems. As a counterpart action, students receive additional training covering essential and basic issues for all courses: Portuguese Language, Financial Education and Entrepreneurship.

Through the Youth Identity Scholarship, annually, dozens of qualified professionals enter the region's job market.

## Acceptance of Scholarship Holders to the proposals

Throughout the semester, students show interest and seriousness in carrying out the tasks. With this, it is inferred that they are able to understand the purpose of the activities, making them a training tool. This is noticeable when almost 80% of regularly enrolled students meet all the criteria for maintaining the Scholarship in the following semesters.

## Control and continuous assistance to students

In addition to the interactions in the Virtual Learning Environment, students had face-to-face support throughout the year to carry out activities. With a teacher and a teaching assistant available at the institution, scholarship holders always have someone to turn to in case of difficulty, thus also having the opportunity to learn about the tools they do not master. In addition, during the semesters, workshops were opened to answer questions and help with tasks, with optional participation.

These are some of the themes developed by the students: Financial planning; Setting of goals; Time management; Healthy eating; Personal presentation, so that the students also have a view on the different situations of everyday life and about taking care of their free time and their own body.

## STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

The Transportation Benefit is a safe, economical and practical way to travel from other cities to attend classes at Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade. Buses from the cities of Quarta Colônia and region arrive daily at the AMF, transporting the wishes of young people who live close to Recanto Maestro to take quality training without having to move to other cities.

Daily, from Monday to Friday at night, and on Saturday mornings, the buses make the itinerary exclusively for AMF students from the cities of São João do Polêsine, Faxinal do Soturno, Nova Palma, Dona Francisca, Agudo, Paraíso do Sul, Candelária, Novo Cabrais, Cachoeira do Sul, Restinga Sêca and Santa Maria. In a safe way and with contractual commitment, the transportation companies receive half of the amount from the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and the rest from the students themselves.

Financially, with the support of 50% of the bus ticket, it is much more feasible for students to travel to the institution. Also, it is a very safe way to travel, since the driving is carried out by a company and specialized professionals.

## An alternative for students residing in neighboring cities

For students who live in neighboring cities and enroll in undergraduate courses at Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade, there is transportation available for displacement, so students can bring their daily experiences to the classroom and take AMF knowledge to their city on a daily basis. The transportation is a possibility to make a restful and safe trip.



## Creation of a parking lot for buses, near the college

In 2022, with the increase in students and transportation that come regularly to college, it was necessary to organize a space for parking buses. Thus, the new location, near the college, makes it safer, as drivers drop off students at the drop-off point and do not need to return, freeing up traffic. Also, this space closer to the institution ensures greater accessibility to transport in case of bad weather or other needs.






## Society in Action: support for cultural and educational projects

## Visits to Institutions



## New buildings and renovations of spaces

Recanto Maestro is daily visited by people from all over the region - and also from distant places. ### Vegetable Garden


The Cultivating the Know-How - Vegetable Garden Project consists of the production and commercialization of vegetables. New undergraduate students and residents at Recanto Maestro have the opportunity to begin their development at Espaço de Cultivo. For this, they are guided by technical professionals in the area who demonstrate how the whole process - from the planting to the sale - of vegetables should be done. The students themselves manage the money involved in the project and have room to contribute at any point in the logistics. This way, Cultivating encourages entrepreneurship and the logic of self-sustainability in participants.

To develop the activities, there is the Cultivation Space. At this place, in addition to the production of vegetables, leafy greens and teas, there is also a commercialization space, open to customers. Thus, the students themselves make the sales and are responsible for collecting and handing the products to the consumers, being part of the project management. Currently, our vegetables are sold to individuals and companies. In addition to residents of Recanto Maestro, many visitors end up consuming the products (and getting to know the vegetable garden itself). In the same way, not only restaurants located in the district, but also in nearby places are permanent clients of the Project. Profits from sales are used to maintain the space.

This way, in addition to developing as producers, these young people work on interpersonal communicative skills, cash control, product handling, customer satisfaction control and countless other aspects that are essential for managing and creating businesses.

## Practical Training

Among the main actions developed in 2022, there was the training of 49 students, on two fronts. Firstly, through technical knowledge about cultivation systems (which ranges from the planning to the commercialization of production) and a second moment with the practical application of this acquired knowledge.

## Healthy and quality products

The project works with around 50 cultivated species, including vegetables, teas and spices. The students participate from preparing the soil to harvesting and delivering products to customers. The production of vegetables is destined for the Recanto Maestro market and also serves the Colibri Restaurante, in the future School of Gastronomy. These activities demonstrate the possibility of a cleaner production through the use of natural fertilizers and products from organic waste that have also been used in the production.



# Cultivating

## The Know-How *Flowers*

The Cultivating the Know-How - Flowers Project was born from the proposal to teach how to observe and pay attention to details. This project, besides being the door to a job opportunity for dozens of young people every six months, contributes to the aesthetics of Recanto Maestro International Center for Humanist Art and Culture. The project focuses on developing technical and human aspects in the participants.

Conducted by technical professionals, students who join the project learn, on a daily basis, how the cultivation and production of flowers, bushes and some species of ornamental trees work. For this, there is a greenhouse and a proper space for the planting and development of plants. From the permanent care, the participants are able to visualize the result of development in the species, which ends up reflecting in their own actions. Thus, in addition to this perception that work generates results, Cultivating requires periodicity, compliance with schedules and responsibility that these students will have to carry out at any other time in their lives.

In addition to contributing to their personal training, Cultivating the Know-How - Flowers is a tool that stimulates a feeling of belonging. Since all species grown in the project's Greenhouse are used to beautify places in Recanto Maestro, students see themselves as truly responsible for the place where they live, thus generating greater care and responsibility for the space.

## RECANTO MAESTRO Dry waste collection

The Recanto Maestro Oikos Project aims at sustainability as an intrinsic factor in contemporary society. The Recanto Maestro Oikos is concerned with raising awareness and care about the proper disposal of recyclable waste produced by residents of the district. To this end, it invests in actions to raise awareness, citizenship and value everyday actions.

Through a partnership with Associação Força no Braço, from Reslinga Seca, it promotes, on a daily basis, the collection of solid waste separated by individuals and companies in Recanto Maestro. The material is collected internally and then removed by the Association, which is responsible for the separation, sale and recycling of solid waste, remaining with the financial resources obtained from this destination. In addition, the Recanto Maestro Oikos organizes educational and cultural activities for the Association's workers, in order to value the work carried out by them.

Waste separation facilitates the recycling of materials, ensuring that most of the resources used may be reused, without the need for disposal in nature. In addition, this practice promotes greater care and reflection about the individual consumption of each one. Still, through its partnerships, the commercialization of the material becomes a way of providing income and dignity to the workers who have, in this service, their livelihood.

The Sowing the Future Project is a project aimed at growing olive trees and providing assistance in production by professionals, in addition to working on the professional training of young people and adults in the region. With this, it is a special project for the generation of more jobs and generation of income, and the increase of the economy of the surrounding cities.

The project inaugurates the pioneering cultivation of olives in the region and opens up the possibility of increasing income for local producers who can visualize, through the experience of Recanto Maestro, a possibility of economic growth - if carried out with care and under proper conditions.

Through the cultivation of olives, it will be possible to carry out the professionalization in this area for countless people. The olives, after being harvested, go through different processes and can be consumed in different formats and for purposes ranging from food to cosmetics.

## Training and technical assistance

The Sowing the Future Project had several training and technical assistance actions in 2022 with partner producers, with the main action being the implementation of an Olive Tree Didactic Orchard, at the State Technical School Dr. Rubens da Rosa Guedes, in the municipality of Caçapava do Sul. It is, therefore, part of the training of new Agricultural Technicians who will be inserted in the job market with specific training in olive tree cultivation.

## An incentive to the cultivation of new crops

A process that is still necessary for the dissemination of olive tree cultivation is the demonstration of its benefits and income possibilities for farmers. This change in mentality is due to the fact that the region has become accustomed to working with annual crops. This is the big difference from olive trees, which are perennial plants, with a completely different cultivation and management system, but totally viable in the region.



## Activities of the year 2022

- **5th AMF Faculty Convention:** On February 15th and 16th, 2022, the 5th Faculty Convention was held, bringing together all professors from the Undergraduate Courses: Administration, Information Systems, Law, Bachelor of Ontopsychology, Degree in Pedagogy and Accounting Sciences. The opening and initial greeting was done by Mrs. Any Rothmann, Strategic Curator of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and Commercial Director of AMF. Next, PhD. Prof. Carolina Cavalcanti, who came from São Paulo, brought her experiences on the field of Active and Innovative Methodologies in Brazil, with a lecture and various practical activities in the form of workshops. In the evening, the professors were able to enjoy the facilities of the Termas Romanas Resort at Recanto Maestro. On the second day, alignment meetings were held for each of the Structuring and Collegiate Faculty of Courses and, in the afternoon, a special event opening for questions and exchange of knowledge among all professors regarding Recanto Maestro, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation, the life and work of Acad. Prof. Antonio Meneghetti and the Ontopsychological Science in Brazil and in the world.

- **Visit to the Scuola Professionale Provinciale Alberghiera Cesare Ritz:** at the beginning of March, a technical visit was made to the Scuola Professionale Provinciale Alberghiera Cesare Ritz, located in the city of Merano, Autonomous Province of Bolzano, Alto Adige, in Italy, by representatives of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and the AMF, to get to know its Board of directors, professors, infrastructure, training method, academic curriculum, aiming at a future institutional partnership for AMF's future undergraduate academic projects: the Superior Course in Hospitality Technology and the School of Gastronomic Sciences and Food Culture with the Bachelor of Gastronomy. The Scuola Cesare Ritz is the only Italian-speaking hotel school in the Province of Bolzano. The Maturity Diploma is equivalent to that obtained in state schools in Italy. Its location in Merano, a city with ancient and consolidated tourist traditions, makes it a privileged interlocutor for the most qualified operators in the tourist-hotel sector. This is yet another activity that reinforces actions in the area of internationality by FAM and AMF, with an interface for the dissemination of Ontopsychological Science as well, which already demonstrates, through this and other partnerships with institutions abroad, that the new AMF Undergraduate Courses will already be international when they come to life.

- **2022 FOIL Award:** with a new public notice presented in March, with a deadline for the production of a narrative text that emphasized what it meant to be part of the AMF Generation. One hundred texts were produced by the participants, among them AMF students and teachers, as well as collaborators from AMF and the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation. This number of 100 very lively texts reports the differential of Ontopsychology being studied, experienced, practiced and applied in the daily lives of young people and professionals. Out of these 100 texts, 28 were written by newcomers/freshmen at the AMF in early 2022, 28 were written by professors, and 44 were written by veteran students. The best texts were evaluated and selected for the new edition of the Fanciullo Collection book in 2022.

- **To the sources of Corporate Humanism:** High-level International Business Training in Holland and Italy: The High-level Business Training, an extension course offered by the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade in partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation, periodically carries out an international edition. The objective of an international event is to be able to expand and confront the Brazilian mentality with the way of doing and serving in other nations, in order to relativize our standards of behavior, as well as providing an opportunity for an intelligent vacation. With this, space is opened for innovation, to qualify the way of doing things and making improvements in our country of origin, Brazil.

Following this logic, from June 9th to 12th, 2022, the group composed of 70 Brazilian businessmen participating in the High-level International Business Training, starting with special activities, visits to companies, scientific, artistic and cultural activities in the cities of The Hague, Rotterdam, Delft and Amsterdam in Holland, and which later moved to the Region of Umbria, in Italy, a region that is the cradle of the precepts of Humanism, as well as a place of strong entrepreneurial development.

The first day began with a guided tour of the splendid and medieval Assisi, a place consecrated to the legacy of Francis of Assisi under the greeting "Peace and Good" (Pax et Bonum). On the same day, the group had the opportunity to visit and enjoy the Valle di Assisi Spa & Golf, an undertaking that hosted many of Antonio Meneghetti's events in Italy, such as the various editions of The Summer University of Ontopsychology. The group was able to learn about its history, as well as the moving potential of the project, through its owner and creator, Mr. Giampiero Bianconi. Finally, "The foundations of entrepreneurial humanism: The monastic entrepreneur" was the theme of the conference developed by Prof. PhD. Paolo Zenorini to the participants.

Continuing, the second day opened with a technical visit to the Arnaldo Caprai Winery, where participants were able to learn more about the excellence of Umbrian wine production, highlighting the famous "Sagrantino de Montefalco" based on the pillars of sustainability, in the cultivation, production and economic and social development of the region.

Afterwards, the group was able to explore the beautiful Montefalco, flanked by vineyards and olive groves, with its medieval features that are more than a thousand years old. In connection with the theme of wine production, as well as food perception and good taste, the day's lectures were given by Dr. Francesco Mignani, who developed the theme "Mens sana in corpore sano" from a bioenergetic medicine point of view; as well as Prof. PhD. Paolo Zenorini continued with the theme of the Fundamentals of Corporate Humanism, delving into the mottos of an active and contemplative life, arising from Bento de Núrsia, Francisco de Assis and Domingos de Gusmão.

The third day of training took place in the Spoleto valley, more specifically at the Monteluco Monastery, founded by Francis of Assisi in 1218. Next to the monastery's hill, with its 850 meters of altitude, the group visited the "Sacred Woods", a place of mystical depth, chosen for the experience of recollection by great people such as St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Bonaventure and others. On the occasion, the participants experienced this important genius loci through the guidance of Mr. Paolo Zampelini, OFM, who highlighted the history of the place, as well as the invitation to balance contemplation and action.

On the same day, the group made its second technical visit, to Antico Frantoio Carletti, a traditional and family-owned olive oil production company, which uses artisanal extraction and production methods since the end of the 17th century.

In the sequence, the participants went to Borgo San Benedetto, that is, to the historic and important town of Lizeri. Received by the Civic Committee of Lizeri, the participants lived in loco important passages of Acad. Prof. Antonio Meneghetti's educational and work actions, who led the restoration of this medieval village in the 1970's. It is the first eco-biological center for ontopsychological training in the world. The emphasis of the visit had as its horizon the unity between the identity of the place and the intentionality of man as a functional unity to the leader in historical action.

To end the days of intense knowledge and personal development, Prof. PhD. Paolo Zenorini delivered the conference on the "7 points of the entrepreneur" from a humanist and ontopsychological point of view. These were certainly days of unforgettable experiences, solid formation and personal renewal.

- **In scientific production:** the new editions of *Saber Humano* and the *Revista Brasileira de Ontopsicologia*: During the year 2022 we had new volumes and new issues of *Saber Humano* – the scientific journal of Faculdade Antonio Meneghetti (ISSN 2446-6298) and *Revista Brasileira de Ontopsicologia* – Brazilian Journal of Ontopsychology (ISSN 2764-9318), launched in 2021. They are scientific journals by the AMF in partnership with the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation, intensifying their disclosures, their open access on digital platforms and increasing their indexing bases for greater visibility to the scientific and the general public, which increases its scientific network. *Saber Humano*, as a novelty, produced a Special Edition called "I see, I do" – Studies in Administration, being a Special Edition with 21 Essays produced by students from the Bachelor of Business Administration at AMF, a scientific work coordinated by Prof. Ms. Rafaela Tagliapietra, demonstrating the interface between the theoretical-technical study and its application in the area of Administration, Management, Entrepreneurship, leadership training with the differential of the FOIL Methodology (Fostering Ontopsychological Interdisciplinary Leadership). The *Revista Brasileira de Ontopsicologia* – Brazilian Journal of Ontopsychology, in its new editions in 2022, received its ISSN 2764-9318 by the Brazilian Institute of Information in Science and Technology (IBICT), presenting ten new scientific articles (seven of them in Portuguese and three in Spanish), reporting research results in the area of Ontopsychology and also in interdisciplinarity with important areas of knowledge and human doing, with the presence of authors and researchers from Brazil and Latin America, including professors, researchers, scientists with a career in the area of Ontopsychological Science and also students of the Bachelor's Degree in Ontopsychology who are already starting their journey as future technicians, teachers and researchers with scientific initiation activities and in partnership with their professors. - **New Classes of the MBA Business Identity and Specialization in Ontopsychology:** In June and July there were inaugural classes for the new Class of the 2022 MBA Business Identity and the 6th Class of Specialization in Ontopsychology at AMF. The classes are made up of 84 professional businessmen, entrepreneurs, lawyers, psychologists, teachers, IT professionals and executives from the most diverse areas of training and performance who have solidified the pursuit of excellence in know-how to do and serve, in knowing themselves, focusing on personal and business development, taking up a unique training course with the differential of the Ontopsychological methodology.

- **Launching of the Acts of the 4th International Congress A New Pedagogy for the Future Society:** On July 2nd and 3rd, 2021, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation for Cultural, Educational, Humanist and Scientific Research held, in partnership with the AMF, the 4th International Congress A New Pedagogy for the Future Society, with the theme "Human Education & Technology – The Education of the Future has already started", with a very rich program of updated, contemporary, international content and several new ideas and practices of innovation in the broad scenario of Education in the 21st century.

The Congress demonstrated how, in practice, Ontopsychology can be used in the education of children, young people and adults. It brought together the region's community and visitors to Recanto Maestro to attend lectures by professors and researchers on Ontopsychological Science and Pedagogy aimed at developing responsible protagonism, in addition to opening space for the practical demonstration of educators from different sectors. With the presence of 200 participants in person at the AMF Auditorium in the two days of the Congress; 4,236 participants in synchronous online/remote format on both days; participants from 13 different countries, including Brazil, Uruguay, Italy, Russia, Ukraine, Latvia, United States, Peru, Switzerland, England, Singapore, Spain, France; dialogues with great professionals in the field of technology and human training, such as the Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation, Mr. Marcos Pontes; the educator Prof. PhD. Gustavo Hoffmann; Prof. PhD. Celso Niskier (President of ABMES); the daughters of the illustrator and businessman Maurício de Souza – Mônica and Magali, in addition to several international professors and the incentive to scientific production, with the presentation of scientific works by 82 Brazilian and International researchers, including Peru, Russia, Ukraine and Uruguay, besides Brazil.

In April 2022, we launched the Acts of the 4th International Congress A New Pedagogy for the Future Society (ISBN 978-85-68901-31-1), digitally, which can be accessed at <https://fundacaoam.org.br/artigoscongressopedagogia>, for the reading of all scientific papers published in full.

- **Meeting of AMF Faculty to open the 2022/2 Semester:** on August 5th, 2022, in the Main Auditorium of the AMF, the Convention of AMF Professors was held. The event aimed at preparing the institution's Faculty, establishing the work dynamics and guidelines for the 2nd semester of 2022. The moment was attended by Course Coordinators and the entire Collegiate of Undergraduate Courses, with special guest Prof. PhD. Andrea Filatro, with a PhD in Education from the University of São Paulo (USP), a relevant professional in terms of working with Innovative Methodologies in the field of Education in Brazil.

**- Launching of Books in the field of Ontopsychology by AMF Professors:** August 5th, 2022: Launching of a scientific research work by Prof. Mami Ueno, professor of the Bachelor in Ontopsychology course, "Teaching Human Values and the Know-how: the essence for quality education", the result of her Master's degree research in the area of Education. It is a study and research on the teaching of human values and know-how. What are the impacts of this teaching on the profile of people and, consequently, on the quality of products and on economic and social development? The idea for the research arises from the observation of the enormous contrast between Brazil's potential (natural and human wealth) and its reality (economic and social development). Brazilian education was compared with two nations that are references in high quality products, which have solid and profound human values and develop manual dexterity: Italy (the cradle of humanism in the West) and Japan (reference as an eastern culture).

July 8th, 2022: Launching of the book "Teacher Education and the Ontopsychological Method: An integrated approach" by Prof. PhD. Carmen Spanhol, professor of the Bachelor in Ontopsychology and Specialization in Ontopsychology, at the AMF Humanitas Library. This book is the result of her Doctoral Thesis in Education at UDELMAR in Chile.

April 1st, 2022: Launching of the book "Ontopsychological Psychotherapy: the formation of the ontotherapist", authored by PhD. Professor Angelo Accorsi Moreira, result of his scientific research in the Graduate Program in Psychology at the Pontifical Catholic University of São Paulo (PUC-SP).

**- Participation of international professors at the Recanto Maestro campus for teaching and academic activities in courses offered by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and AMF:** As a relevant activity within the Research and Dissemination of Ontopsychology Program, the Recanto Maestro campus usually receives professors and international technicians-operators of the Ontopsychological Science, for special activities, carrying out exchanges and sharing knowledge, ideas and innovation in their professional activities with teachers, collaborators and students of Educational and Cultural Projects from the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and AMF activities. During the classes of Perennial Philosophy at Capodanno 2022, Prof. Paolo Zenorini (from Bolzano, Alto Adige, Italy) was present carrying out training activities. In February, Prof. Elena Lyutikova, from Russia, was present teaching classes in the first Module of the High-Level Business Training Course MasterClass for the year 2022.

In the training activities in Italy, during the month of June 2022, the classes of the International Module of the High-level Business Training, at the Valle di Assisi Hotel & Spa, in the Umbria Region, were carried out by International entrepreneurs and professors, Mr. Paolo Zenorini, Mr. Francesco Mignani (Physiotherapist and representative of the Comune di Assisi, PG, Italy), Mr. Gianpiero Bianconi (Italian businessman and owner of the Valle di Assisi Hotel & Spa), Ms. Suzanna Bianconi (Manager of the Valle di Assisi Hotel & Spa), Mr. Fausto Pieroni (Italian accountant and businessman, deputy President of the Civico Committee of Lizzori), and Mr. Paolo Zampelini (representative of the Minori Order of Franciscans).

Prof. Paolo Zenorini was also present in Brazil during the months of August and September, for special activities at the Isomaster School - a new project restarted in 2022 by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation in Brazil, based on the Acad. Prof. Antonio Meneghetti's work - also holding the Inaugural Class of the 2022/2 Semester of the Bachelor in Ontopsychology and a Special International Class for the School of Pedagogical Innovations Course at AMF. In November, he returned to the activities of the second Module of the Isomaster School.

**- Special Training (Re)discovering the Enchantment of Education: Challenges and Possibilities:** In Extension activities with the application of Ontopsychological knowledge and Ontopsychological Pedagogy. On August 1st, 2022, it was held the Meeting of teachers and education professionals from the Municipal Public Network of Restinga Sêca - RS, at the Recanto Maestro International Center for Humanist Art and Culture, aiming to further train the teachers and educational servers to return to school in the second half of 2022. A partnership between the Municipality of Restinga Sêca with the Project "We are Together" by the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation, the event, which had about 270 participants, was attended by the Secretary of Education of Restinga, Mrs. Sílvia Mohr, the Mayor, Mr. Paulinho Salerno and, representing Recanto Maestro, Mrs. Any Rothmann, Strategic Curator of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation.

During the day, participants had the opportunity to attend classes taught by professionals specialized in the field of Education, such as: Prof. Michael Penna, Coordinator of the Project We are Together from the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and teacher at the Recanto Maestro Youth Orchestra; Prof. Patrícia Wazlawick, Coordinator of the Bachelor's Degree in Ontopsychology; Prof. Márcia Marchezan, Coordinator of the Degree in Pedagogy and Prof. Arianna Alejandra Gutierrez Castillo, graduate from the First Class of Pedagogy of the AMF and teacher of the Recanto Maestro Youth Orchestra, all working on themes related to personal and professional training in Ontopsychology, Ontopsychological Pedagogy and pedagogical innovations for teacher training and professional updating.

- **Presentations of the Small Theses from the 6th Class of the Bachelor in Ontopsychology:** The Bachelor of Ontopsychology presents and develops the Small Theses project in curricular components throughout the course, as a special scientific initiation activity for the development of skills on reading, writing, thinking, scientific rationality, philosophical posture, and, above all, study, skills that are so valuable to be developed in contemporary times and especially with the younger generations. This way, the student ventures into each of these skills and abilities that are so necessary in the midst of a world that is increasingly immersed in the supremacy of digital power, while thinking, reflecting and writing, researching the theory and practical application of Ontopsychology, creating learning networks and exchanges with their colleagues and professors and also during the moment of presenting their Small Thesis to an evaluation board.

**Isomaster School:** Another novelty for 2022, the Isomaster School consists of an immersion of socializing with high-performance entrepreneurs, professors and international consultants. Isomaster means the one who is capable of being equal, the master capable of being equal to the ontic In-Sé. Isomaster is a vocabulary composed of two terms: iso, from the Greek, which means "equal", and master, which means "someone who is three times more", that is, a master.

It takes place at the Recanto Maestro International Center for Humanist Art and Culture, precisely because of the need for an ecological environment with living and healthy nature. The course's proposal is to broaden the business metaphysical view and allow management with greater overall success and inner satisfaction for any personal, business or social change and transformation. In order to do this, it deepens in the studies of the works of Antonio Meneghetti. There are few contemporary authors who bring together such a plural classical academic background as Antonio Meneghetti. And even rarer are those who, along with a robust intellectual path, also have a demonstrated and recognized entrepreneurial path. Italian by birth, but international by training and experience, the patron of Recanto Maestro wrote many books and was a consultant on economics and politics to businessmen from around the world, being himself a successful entrepreneur in the fields of culture, education and science.

The Isomaster School is aimed at entrepreneurs and leaders who seek to constantly expand their capacity and power of action, in order to put this knowledge into practice. It is an in-depth course, as it seeks to ascend to humanity, therefore, to know the essence of existence, of the historical identity itself.

**- The Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and the AMF participated in the 4th ABMES International Delegation in Portugal:** From October 25th to November 5th, 2022, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and the AMF participated of the 4th International Delegation promoted by the Brazilian Association of Higher Education Supporters (ABMES), in Portugal, along with managers, maintainers and educational leaders of more than 30 private universities and colleges in Brazil. The event, called Portugal Experience, promoted a true academic immersion in university projects with a long history and tradition and in modern and innovative projects developed by Portuguese Universities.

In order to visit and get to know the main higher education institutions in this European country, the Mission was focused on three main axes: political, academic and cultural, emphasizing five pillars, namely: internationalization, innovation, entrepreneurship, health and the management model of European Higher Education. During the entire period of visits to Portuguese institutions, it was possible not only to be among the Universities and their representatives, but, mainly, to establish effective agreements, learn about successful cases that can be applied in Brazilian HEIs, experience the cultural opportunities of Portugal, in short, days of hands-on experiences, a lot of learning, new ideas, debates, proposed solutions and many established partnerships.

During the entire period, 18 Portuguese institutions were visited. The visits began on October 26th, 2022, at the Universidade Lusófona do Porto (ULusófona), and on all other days of the period they continued at the following HEIs: Instituto Politécnico do Porto (P. Porto), Cooperativa de Ensino Superior Politécnico e Universitário (CESPU), University of Aveiro (UA), Altice Labs SA, PCI. Creative Science Park Aveiro Region, Polytechnic Institute of Coimbra (IPC), University of Coimbra (UC), Brazilian Embassy in Portugal, Web Summit Lisboa 2022, Universidade Lusíada, Grêmio Literário de Lisboa, Universidade Católica Portuguesa (UCP), Higher Education Management Forum in Portuguese Speaking Countries and Regions (FORGES), University of Lisbon (ULisboa), Nova SBE - Nova School of Business and Economics, ending on November 4th, 2022, at Universidade Nova de Lisboa. In addition to museums, artistic and cultural spaces, and the production of grapes and wine in Portugal.

As a result, the 4th ABMES International Delegation in Portugal visited 18 Portuguese institutions; ten cooperation agreements were signed; doctoral scholarships agreed with Universidade Lusófona; vacancies for internships at Altice Labs; vacancies for undergraduate exchanges in all institutions visited; organization of webinars with the participation of Portuguese professors; formation of evaluation boards for master's and doctoral degrees with Portuguese professors, and several conversations between Brazilian and Portuguese institutions were initiated. In addition to the knowledge acquired and the contacts made, including the exchange of experiences among the members of the mission, it was a historic edition of the already traditional International Delegation of the Association.

The Foundation and the AMF were introduced to each of the institutions mentioned above, highlighting and drawing attention to the novelty of Ontopsychological Science and have already returned with a Scientific and Academic Cooperation Agreement signed with the Lusófona University (in Porto and Lisbon), and immediately another three agreements are in progress, in addition to many other new partnerships and activities that can be carried out to further intensify the internationality of students and teachers, developing and also providing important moments of international training for our students and teachers.




## Activities in 2022:

On June 6th, 2022, the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation for Cultural, Educational, Humanist and Scientific Research, together with the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade (AMF), held the International Symposium Person & Society in the Conference Room of the Leonardo Royal Hotel Promenade in the city Den Haag ("Haia" in Portuguese and "The Hague" in English) in the Netherlands, which received an audience of 180 participants, among them young students, liberal professionals, businessmen and leaders of the United Nations (UN) and the Netherlands. The public came from four countries, namely: Brazil, the Netherlands, Ukraine and Italy.

During a lifetime of scientific, philosophical and entrepreneurial work for the development of young people, professionals, entrepreneurs and leaders, training leaders to act actively and efficiently in the social context, Acad. Prof. Antonio Meneghetti was invited as an international lecturer and also organized hundreds of congresses, conventions, scientific meetings at the highest levels of discussion and decision-making worldwide.

This International Symposium Person and Society is the result of a long and fruitful history of collaboration with the principles, initiatives and agencies of the United Nations, initiated by Prof. Antonio Meneghetti more than 20 years ago and carried forward today by the Foundations he created in Brazil and in the world. Understanding the differentials obtained, that the trainings with Antonio Meneghetti provided, and carrying forward the legacy and work of Ontopsychological Science in Brazil and in the world, it was on this day, June 6th, 2022, the moment to think, discuss and present in the city of The Hague, in the Netherlands, what people and what society we need to be and contribute to an integral formation.

With the theme "Person and Society", the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation chose this International Symposium to launch its newest book from the Collection "Antonio Meneghetti on...". In one of the conferences given by Prof. Meneghetti, present in this work, he states:

*"Today, with globalization, the superiority of the person is possible, it is a great event for the human personality. To have the first respect for social service. There is no true great genius if there is not also a social function".*

Inaugurating the International Symposium "Person & Society", the event was opened by Mrs. Babiche Wouters Van Den Oudnweijer (representing The Hague Convention Center and The Hague Municipal Department of Tourism); Mr. Martin Born (Directorate for International Affairs - Municipality of The Hague); Mr. Emerson Novais Lopes (Head of the Trade and Investment Promotion Sector at the Brazilian Embassy in The Hague); Ms. Silvia Vacchi (Representative of the United Nations Institute of Training and Research); Mrs. Helena Biasotto (Institutional Director of the Antonio Meneghetti Faculdade); Mr. Almir Foletto (Chairman of the Deliberative Council of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation) and Mrs. Any Rothmann (Strategic Curator of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation).

This international event supported the following movements of the United Nations: Global Compact; PRIME - the Principles for Responsible Management Education; Academic Impact; Commitment to Sustainable Practices by Higher Education Institutions and the UN Sustainable Development Goals.





Shortly after the opening of the event, the International Symposium received its guest of honor, Her Royal Highness Princess Petra Laurentien Brinkhorst of the Netherlands, a great personality and intelligence of contemporary Dutch history, with a great career in the field of Journalism, Education and in the Social area. Princess Laurentien studied History at the University of the Netherlands and also took a Bachelor of Political Science at Queen Mary College, University of London; she holds a Masters in Journalism from the University of California, Berkeley, United States; and built an extensive career in the area of international communication, working for several international communication and advertising agencies; she also acts as Coordinator in several actions in the Social and Educational areas of the Netherlands, jointly with projects of the United Nations and UNESCO.

In 2017, Princess Laurentien founded, together with Prince Constantijn Christof Frederik Aschwin, the Foundation entitled "Number 5 Foundation". And this is the entity that connected the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation to her, a philanthropic entity that currently develops several works and innovative projects that address a series of social issues. The initiative to invite the Number 5 Foundation to this event happened because we understand that there is a deep connection of values between our foundations, namely, the Number 5 Foundation and the FAM. We are very honored for the opportunity to exchange, share knowledge and learning with Princess Laurentien during the International Symposium Person and Society. The main objective of the Number 5 Foundation, to foster the connection between people committed to an innovation that contributes to a fair and sustainable society, has a lot of connection with the work we carry out in our educational and cultural projects in Brazil.

We believe that dialogues focused on cultural facts, interests of different social actors, practical experiences and perceptions of the dilemmas of our current society bring solutions for building a better future, aiming to achieve the SDGs and the 2030 Agenda, noting that both Foundations work jointly in this field. Working to achieve the SDGs requires actions in local practice, with a vision of global impact, aligned with an international mindset.

The work focused on educating children and young people to be global citizens makes it absolutely essential to exchange experiences with entities such as the Number 5 Foundation. It is necessary to connect internationally with those who are committed to the innovation to build a better future, not just for us, but for the youth of future generations.

Special and thought-provoking ideas about dialogue, change, problems and different ways of looking at situations were just the first learnings of a grandiose class that all 180 participants had with Princess Laurentien during an entire hour of the International Symposium that was dedicated to the speech of Her Highness. This was her appeal, that all people in their ivory towers go down the ladder, connect with other people and with other types of knowledge, generate dialogue. Many people can be part of this exchange but not be those who facilitate the dialogue, and our task is really this, in the end, to facilitate communication, because equality, opportunities and exchanges need to be facilitated.

When the Princess finished her speech at the International Symposium, she opened space for questions, and, in a very participatory way, a student from the AMF Information Systems Course, Iuri Piccolini Moro, stood up and asked the Princess a question in English. Then we had Patrick Milano, a graduate of the Business Administration Course, who also asked his question in English, and three more Law students who asked questions to Her Royal Highness, Princess Laurentien.

With great joy, respect and honor, the first part of the International Symposium ended when the Princess concluded her participation, which, in a very special way, honorably and with an immense responsibility, touched all the participants present at that moment.

From the second part of the event onwards, two more equally important moments were held. The first, the Panel entitled "Person and Society", with the presence of three Brazilian businessmen, Directors of the Antonio Meneghetti Foundation and Professors of the International Business Training Course. Mr. Carlos Gennari, a businessman in the field of civil construction in São Paulo, addressed the theme "The operability of Ontopsychology and the Future of the UN: the commitment of Ontopsychology within the United Nations".

This was followed by the presentation of Mr. Wesley Lacerda, an entrepreneur in the area of viticulture and wine production, who addressed the theme "Ontopsychology for the third millennium: the future of knowledge in the world". And, to close this Panel, we had the presentation of Mr. Claudio Carrara, an entrepreneur in the Information Technology sector, with the theme "The importance of Brazil's protagonism in the world: the responsibility of business, political, intellectual leaders and also young people".

The second panel, called "Youth and Society" gave space and voice to young people, to those individuals who will build our future. The young students Cauê Vieira, an AMF Business Administration student; the student Sofia Bevilacqua Trevisan, a student of the Bachelor's Degree in Ontopsychology at the AMF and the graduate of Law and youngest professor at the AMF, Wilian Friedrich Neu. They addressed the importance of carrying out the Training Course with UNITAR, the United Nations Institute for Training and Research, a branch for training and education also for young people, from the United Nations system; the importance of the dialectics between rights and duties mainly in relation to the role played by young people in the contemporary world; and the protagonism and responsibility of young people within their nation and also in the international context. The AMF's internationality pillar is a differential for all its young undergraduate students.

Finally, the International Symposium had the beautiful, serious and responsible speech of Mrs. Any Rothmann, Strategic Curator of the FAM, contextualizing this international event, its importance and the great responsibility of each person who was there and who participated in this moment. In the first place, responsibility towards oneself, to learn, to experience new things and to carry out at least one change and improvement in oneself throughout this period. And, from this, the responsibility to act, to do, to work, to innovate in their companies, their businesses, in their studies, in order to contribute to a change that can be built every day in the social context.
